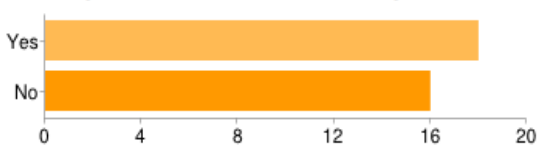

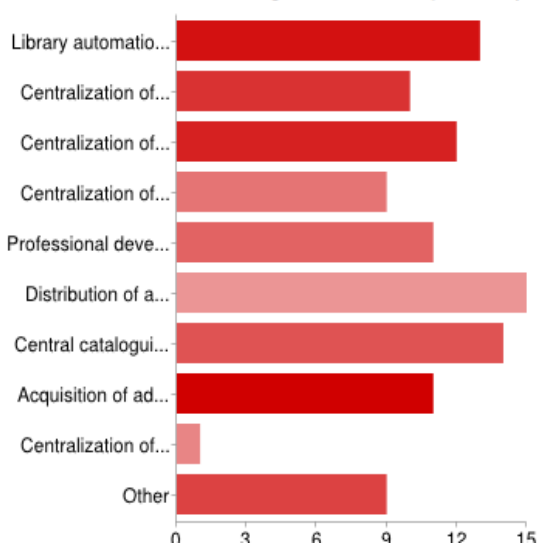
2a. Does your district have centralized library and media services?

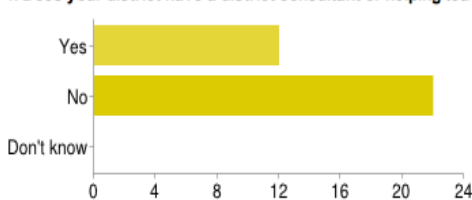
3b. If Yes, which of the following services does it provide? (Select all that apply)

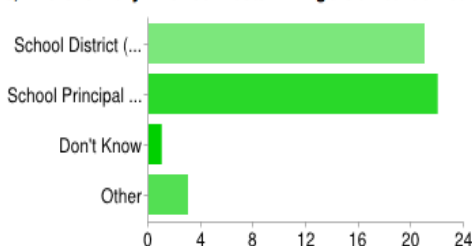
4. Does your district have a district consultant or helping teacher for Teacher-Librarians and school libraries?
